1 (present simple)

The world's forests are very important. Billions of tonnes of CO₂ ¹ are absorbed (absorb) by trees. Most of the world's rain ² is produced (produce) by the forests, too. They also provide homes for many animals. When a forest ³ is destroyed (destroy), a lot of animals ⁴ are killed (kill). Others ⁵ are driven out (drive out) by all the noise.

2 (future with will)

In the future, some important minerals on Earth ⁶ will be used up (use up). What will happen then? Some people think that minerals ⁷ will be found (find) on other planets or on asteroids. Spaceships ⁸ will be sent (send) into space, the minerals ⁹ will be mined (mine) and they ¹⁰ will be transported (transport) back to Earth. The work ¹¹ will be done (do) by robots.

The area of Newlands used to be a dirty industrial site, but in the last few years, it ¹² has been changed (change) into a beautiful natural park.
